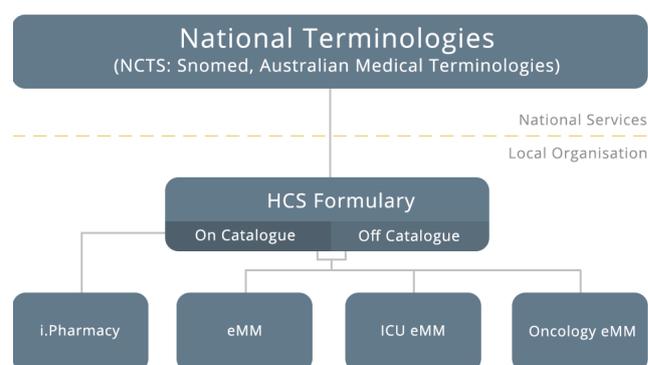
The solution can also be supported by sub-formularies, which are alternative views of HCS Formulary from the perspective of either a specialty or a regional area within the organisation. This allows for information relevant to that area of practice to be presented to those working within that discipline. Examples of sub formularies for specialist areas may include cardiothoracic, neonatal or palliative care, or alternatively remote country services. This recognises that special and different guidance may be required due to differences in practice requirements and usage of medicines.

HCS Formulary is contemporary software. It can be delivered as true cloud or locally installed software that is scalable and captures the needs and uses on an organisation basis.

## Features for system users

- **Organisation list of approved medicines** showing availability, preferred agents, restrictions and requirements, complemented by information on non-approved medicines;
- **Comprehensive medicine details** including local restrictions, indications for use, strength, formulation, pack size and cost;
- **Links, guidelines and procedures** related to that medication, including local, organisational, national and clinical resources.
- **Integration** with dispensing software for stock availability, location and Active Directory integration for authentication of users;
- **Enterprise system that** allows whole of organisation information to be managed effectively and accurately from a single source;
- **Web based system** working with any operating system.
